**SHOW/BREEDING POTENTIAL DOG GUARANTEE
The minimum standards as accepted by the MPDBA are as follows:**

The show or breeding potential dog is an adult dog or pup that goes above and beyond the definition of a pet dog. This animal must be purebred, registerable with the AKC, and be free of all disqualifying faults for its particular breed at the time of sale. This dog is in no way guaranteed to win in the show ring. It is understood that with proper care and training on the part of the buyer, in due time the dog should be of an acceptable temperament and structure and should embody the basic standards of the breed. No other warranties or guarantees, expressed or implied are made under this contract except as follows:

1. The dog is purebred and the pedigree is correct and given at the time of sale. The dog is registerable with the AKC *unless* the form is withheld per written agreement. REFUND: 100% provided dog and registration papers are returned to seller.
2. The health of this animal is guaranteed for TEN (10) days via examination by a veterinarian at the option and expense of the buyer. If the dog is found to be in unsatisfactory health and written documentation of the condition is presented, the seller shall, provided the dog and its registration papers are returned, at seller's option: (buyer and seller to initial options agreed upon below):

One of these veterinarians to be a tenured faculty member of an accredited university veterinary teaching hospital or Board Certified in the applicable specialty. **Veterinary expenses** are to be assumed by the buyer. - Confine the animal in a fenced yard or kennel run, or walk on a leash--**not to confine on a rope or chain.**
- If the buyer decides to sell or otherwise dispose of this dog, seller has the first right of refusal.
